If your child is not able to get their exam before final registration due to insurance timeframes, please bring the scheduled date of the next exam during final registration.

<u>Preschoolers need:</u> Birth Certificate (may be a copy), Current health physical form and proof of immunizations.

<u>Kindergarten:</u> Birth Certificate (may be a copy), Health physical, proof of up to date immunizations, Lead level test, Eye Exam, and Dental Exam <u>2nd grade:</u> Dental Exam

<u>6th grade:</u> Health exam with up-to-date immunizations, Dental Form

<u>Grades 3-8</u>-if playing sports: Sports Physical Sixth graders health physical will count as a sports physical, but a sports physical will not count as a health exam!






