On Tuesday, March 18 at 7pm Zion Lutheran School will host an open house for parents interested in learning about Zion's Preschool and Kindergarten programs. We offer a 3-year-old preschool class which meets from 12:30-3 on Tuesday and Thursdays. Our 4am class meets Monday-Friday from 8-11:20am. Children must be 3 on or before September 1, 2025 to be eligible for the 3-year-old class and 4 on or before September 1, 2025 to be eligible for the 4-year-old class. Full and part time daycare are also available for preschool age students. In order to be eligible for Kindergarten a child must be 5 on or before September 1, 2025. Zion offers full day Kindergarten with before and after school care available.

Registration forms for Preschool and Kindergarten will be distributed at the open house along with the registration schedule for preschool registration. Registration will take place on Thursday, April 3, 2025 for Preschool while Kindergarten forms can be returned anytime after open house.
