

Full time: Children are charged \$150 each week of summer. Lunch is included in this price. You will also qualify for one week of vacation in which your child will not be charged. The week must be a Monday-Friday of the same week and the director will need one week's notice that you will be using your vacation week. Your child may not be in attendance for any part of your vacation week. There will be a \$25 registration fee on your first summer bill for all school aged children (entering 1st grade and older).

Part time: Each child is charged for a minimum of 2 days per week. This will be charged EVERY week of summer at the price of \$36 per day. You may attend up to 5 days for the week. You will also qualify for one week of vacation in which your child will not be charged. The week must be a Monday - Friday of the same week and the director will need one week's notice that you will be using your vacation week. Your child may not be in attendance for any part of your vacation week. Lunch is an additional fee of \$3 per day and will be included in your weekly bill. There will be a \$25 registration fee on your first summer bill for all school aged children (entering 1st grade and older)
